



# ISCC's Synchronized Skating Team

## Eligibility

All participants of the Learn to Skate program, Kid's Class, Freestyle Workshops, Charter Oak Figure Skating Club Members, and those skaters who skate and train at ISCC. Skaters who have tested with US Figure Skating can not have tested higher than Preliminary to be eligible for the Synchronized Skating team.

## Synchronized Skating Team

Students will have 60 minutes of on ice group instruction. Students will work on skills from the US Figure Skating Synchronized Skills levels. Students will be taught by ISCC's staff of world class coaches. Focus will be on team moves and creating team spirit.

## Synchronized Skating Team Policies and Procedures

Due to space and coaching availability, this Synchronized Skating Team will only run when 5 students are registered. ISCC reserves the right to cancel the Synchronized Skating Team if there is not sufficient registration.

There are no refunds given once a skater is registered, unless the Synchronized Skating Team is cancelled. If a skater withdraws from the program, ISCC will issue a credit for future programs.

All skaters in the International Skating Center of Connecticut's Synchronized Skating Team program must be current members of the United Figure Skating Association. This membership renews annually. The membership year is September 1, 2007 to August 31, 2008. The fee for this membership is \$20 per skater.

## Synchronized Skating Team Program Mission and Goals

Our goal is to teach the fundamentals of skating using a variety of safe and enjoyable instructional techniques using the US Figure Skating's Synchronized Skating Program. This program is for the skater who wishes to be part of a team and further enhance their skating skills. The skaters must be at least Basic 2 level to participate in the Synchronized Skating Team, unless prior permission has been granted by the Synchronized Skating Team Director.
